

Administrative Procedure 300

Admission of Non-board Students

Background

Non-board students may be admitted to Renfrew County District School Board schools in accordance with the Education Act and this administrative procedure.

Procedure

1. Students from outside the jurisdiction of Renfrew County District School Board who have the right under the Education Act to attend a school, shall be admitted and fees will be charged in accordance with provincial legislation.
2. Students from outside the board's jurisdiction who do not have the right under the Education Act to attend a school, may be admitted subject to the following conditions:
 - 1) There is sufficient accommodation in the school and classes will not be overcrowded as a result of the students' admission.
 - 2) Fees will be calculated and paid in accordance with the regulations made under the Education Act. No fees will be charged during the interim period for change of tax support for students transferring from the Catholic school system to the public school system.
 - 3) Students from Ontario who take up residence in Renfrew County shall be regarded as resident students and shall be admitted without payment of fees under the following circumstances:
 - a) the student has left the previous school in good standing;
 - b) prior to coming to Renfrew County, the student was a resident in Ontario.
 - 4) During a teacher strike in another jurisdiction, students from that area may be admitted to Renfrew County District School Board schools, subject to the availability of space in the desired courses and with the authorization of the Director of Education.
